Send all paperwork (GSCA Adults and Minors under 18 Liability Forms also West Nile vaccination record as required by landowner — **NOTE:** Coggins is no longer required) TO [cindy.schlener@charter.net](mailto:cindy.schlener@charter.net) or mail to Cindy Schlener, 147 Williamsville Rd., Hubbardston, MA 01452. Please specify whether you are staying the whole weekend or just coming for a day (day trip available only Friday or Saturday.) Please state how many trailers you are bringing and style/size (e.g. 3-horse gooseneck.) Parking is limited.

*There is no charge for current members. Guests riding or driving a horse must complete a Membership application (\$25) per insurance requirements. Non-riding guests or guests in carriages need to complete a Liability form.*

Cindy will reply to all Pre-registrations to validate receipt. Please include email address if available, or Tel. number, on Liability form for reply. Send all required forms together, which must be received by Cindy no later than July 1. There will be a cut off when all parking/camping sites have been taken.

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***Ride and Drive*** in the scenic Lakes Region on miles of Chocorua gravel roads. Follow the shady Paugus Brook trail and enjoy great carriage driving and trail riding through Hemenway State Forest. Try the trail for riders to the Fire Tower. You can ride or drive to beautiful Chocorua Lake and up to the spectacular vista at Mountain View

*Farm. Expect hills on this ride so pace your horse if not conditioned. Short distances—4-6 miles— and much longer are available.*

***Camp at Coruway Farm***, below Mt. Chocorua, where LeGrand Cannon penned 'Look to the Mountain.' Take a refreshing **swim or paddle** in Chocorua Lake, not far from camp.

*Please bring your own drinking water supply. Water will be available for horses. A porta-potty will be on the grounds. Dogs are allowed, but must be restrained around riders & drivers. Please inform Cindy of the day and approximate time of your arrival. Don't forget the 'slow vehicle' / orange triangle sign for the back of your carriage for safety. **Minors under 18 must wear helmets.** Sorry, there is no stabling available.*

***Let's gather around the campsite Saturday night for pizza and potluck!***

#### **FROM ROUTE 93 NORTH OR SOUTH:**

**Exit 23 on Route 93 to 104 East** to Meredith.

Take Route **25 East** to Center Harbor, through Moultonborough, E. Sandwich, S. Tamworth and Whittier.

Take Route **113 East** (left) to Tamworth. Stay on **113 East**.

At Tamworth intersection, take **right** to continue on **113 East** to Chocorua. (**NOT 113A**)

Look for brown building w/sign "Rutabaga" (former church) on left. Slow down, and take **2ND sharp left** very shortly past Rutabaga onto **Philbrick Neighborhood Rd. (gravel road.)**

Watch for "**The Preserve at Chocorua**" sign. Go approx. 1 mile to Peggy Cannon's house (grey/green) on left. Park in field, through the gate across from the house— NOT by the barn.

#### **FROM THE EAST:**

From **Route 16** take **113 West** and look for **Philbrick Neighborhood Rd. on right.**
