Enjoy riding or driving at Bear Brook State Park, the largest developed state park in NH at over 10,000 acres. Mix of wood trails and gravel roads (packed like a driveway). Enjoy going past marshes, bogs, and ponds and hearing/seeing the wildlife. Two different loops – an 8 mile and 12 mile.

No Bear Brook state park entrance reservation is needed for this outing.

There is a \$4 state entrance fee for the park.
