Enjoy the peace and quiet of the Mason Rail Trail nestled among the forest of Mason. No houses – go as far as you like before turning back.

For drivers, there are a couple of local dirt/paved road crossings – it's a lovely green tunnel through the many rocky ravines. Quite smooth except for a minor washout area.

For riders there are a few road crossings, a small bridge crossing and water at Pratt Pond. The cart path through Russell-Abbott State Forest is a hidden gem and allows riders the ability to come back a slightly different way.

For both, there is a distance of up to 11 miles back and forth

Directions to Parking:

Parking is at the town of Mason's sand pit on Sand Pit Rd (a dirt road). The sand pit is located between Wilton Rd and the Mason Rail Trail . GPS coordinates are 42.7650062, -71.7513036. There will be signs on sand pit road pointing to the sand pit.

Take rt 123 into the center of Mason. Turn onto Meeting House Hill and continue until Wilton Rd. Make a right onto Wilton and continue until Sand Pit Rd on the right (look for GSCA sign). Make a right onto Sand Pit road passing a baseball field on the right. Continue until a GSCA sign appears – sand pit will be on the right.
