The Maze trails are reasonably wide and curvy. Sleights are to stop for riders/ski-jorers/skiers/sleds in either direction. Southern NH Snow Slickers groom and will post notices of horses in the area in

advance, to use caution for horses... snowmobiles, dog sleds/mushers, hikers and dog-walkers may be present.

There will be a couple of soups and assorted warm drinks offered. There will be no facilities at this location but there is a Dunkin' Donuts not too far away.

All participants must be current Members of GSCA and must have signed a GSCA Liability Release. Liability and Membership Forms are online and will also be available at the Outing Sign-In.

Mileage will be limited for sake of horses' winter fur coats. Hope to see you all out in the snow!

**DIRECTIONS to Parking:**

**NH Route 101 (between Manchester & the Seacoast), Exit 2**

**Turn right at the end of the ramp if coming from Manchester Area or I-93,**

**Turn left at the end of the ramp if coming from the Seacoast Area or Maine**

**Follow Hooksett Rd. south,**

**Depot Road is the 2<sup>nd</sup> road on the left about ½ mile from NH 101.**

**Turn onto Depot Road and the field is about 1000 feet ahead on right.**

**Follow the GSCA signs.**
