PLEASE READ ALL:

I have made no misrepresentation to The Granite State Carriage Association (“GSCA”) and the Host(s) of this event regarding my name, address, age, riding/driving ability, health insurance or any other information that was requested. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless GSCA and its members, officers, directors, volunteers, agents, and the landowners over whose property this drive/ride might take place, and the Host(s) of this event for any loss or damage, including any that result from claims for personal injury or property damage related to the use of my horse (and carriage). I understand that this Release shall remain in effect during the entire drive/ride and that this Release shall apply to any and all activities that I may do connected with said drive/ride, whether on or behind a horse or not. I also understand that this drive/ride may be in areas not easily accessible in the event of an emergency and that a considerable delay may occur before anyone becomes aware that I need assistance and before assistance can arrive.

I understand and am aware that carriage driving and horseback riding is **INHERENTLY A HAZARDOUS ACTIVITY AND DESPITE THE BEST INTENTIONS OF THE GSCA, THE LANDOWNERS, AND THE HOST(S) OF THIS EVENT, ACCIDENTS CAN HAPPEN.** I

understand that the above activities and the use of horses involves a risk of injury to any and all parts of my body, dismemberment, or death. I realize that wearing a helmet can reduce the chances of serious head injury. I further understand that this Release applies to any accident or injury that may occur at this event, whether connected to horses or not.

Having read the above paragraphs and understanding them, I hereby release the GSCA and its members, officers, directors, volunteers, agents, and the landowners over whose property this drive/ride might take place, and the Host(s) of this event FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY FOR DAMAGES AND

PERSONAL INJURY TO MYSELF OR ANY PERSON OR PROPERTY RESULTING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE GSCA, THE LANDOWNERS, AND THE HOST(S) OF THE EVENT, TO INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, NEGLIGENCE IN TRAIL CONDITION, ROAD AND TRAFFIC CONDITIONS, AND THE ACTIONS OF OTHER HORSES OR INDIVIDUALS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE GSCA, THE LANDOWNERS, AND THE HOST(S) OF THIS EVENT, accepting to myself full responsibility for any and all damages or injury of any kind which may result from the inherent dangers involved in being in the presence of horses or at this event.

I agree that there have been no warranties, expressed or implied, which have been made to me which extend beyond a general description of the route. I, the undersigned, acknowledge that I have carefully read this Release of Liability and I understand its contents.

I UNDERSTAND THAT MY SIGNATURE BELOW EXPRESSLY WAIVES ANY AND ALL RIGHTS I HAVE TO SUE THE GSCA, OR ANY MEMBER, OFFICER, DIRECTOR, VOLUNTEER, OR AGENT THEREOF, THE LANDOWNER OVER WHOSE PROPERTY THIS DRIVE/RIDE MIGHT TAKE PLACE, OR THE HOST(S) OF THIS EVENT FOR ANY AND ALL INJURIES, DAMAGES OR OTHER DETRIMENTAL RESULTS THAT MAY OCCUR WHILE I AM AT THIS EVENT EVEN IF SAID INJURY, DAMAGE OR OTHER DETRIMENTAL RESULT IS CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE GSCA, THE LANDOWNERS, OR THE HOST(S) OF THE EVENT.

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ADDENDUM

ATTENTION - STATE LIABILITY LAWS!

Under NEW HAMPSHIRE Law, a Participant in Equine Activities Assumes the Risk of Any Injury, Harm, Damage, or Death and Any Legal Responsibility That May Occur to Participant Resulting From the Inherent Risks Associated With Equine Activities. Pursuant to R.S.A. 508:19, equine professionals are not liable for damages resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

Under MAINE Law, an Equine Professional Has Limited Liability for an Injury or Death Resulting From the Inherent Risks of Equine Activities. [1999, c. 498 §5(new).]

Under MASSACHUSETTS Law, an Equine Professional is Not Liable for an Injury to, or the Death of, a Participant in Equine Activities Resulting From the Inherent Risks of Equine Activities. Pursuant to Section 2D of Chapter 128 of the General Laws.

Under VERMONT Law, an Equine Activity Sponsor is Not Liable for an Injury to, or the Death of, a Participant in Equine Activities Resulting from the Inherent Risks of Equine Activities That are Obvious and Necessary. Pursuant to 12 V.S.A. §1039.

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
