WHAT IS SHELBURNE FARMS? www.shelburnefarms.org

Just south of Burlington, VT, Shelburne Farms opens its stable doors to the GSCA again this year. The Farm is located on the shores of Lake Champlain, with 1,400 scenic acres, miles of dirt roads, and woods and field trails. Originally a Vanderbilt/Webb family estate and designed by Frederick Law Olmstead, Shelburne Farms features unbelievably huge Adirondack-style mansions and barns interesting in their own right; a working dairy barn; cheese-making on site; Farm Barn with activities and farm animals; Market Garden; gift shop. Shelburne Farms is a non-profit organization promoting environmental and agricultural education to the public
